Biobased products are intermediate materials and products that are composed in whole, or in significant part, of biological products, renewable agricultural materials or forestry materials. The program is designed to:

- Spur economic development, by providing new markets for farm commodities;
- Reduce reliance on petroleum;
- Increase the use of renewable agriculture resources;
- Contribute to reducing adverse environmental and health impacts.
