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

Section 301 of the Trade Act of 1974

Grants the president the right to respond to unfair trade practices

August 2017

U.S. Trade Representative launches an investigation

March 2018

U.S. Trade Representative releases findings indicating that China is conducting unfair trade practices

July 2018

U.S. made threat to hit all imports from China with tariff increases, meaning retailers had more than a year to shift production before increases were implemented

Rapprochement

Both sides move away from escalation in early fall Planned tariff increases on List 4b abandoned

Phase One Deal

Tariff increases on List 4a halved effective Feb. 14

List 4a

\$112 billion

15 ppt tariff increase

Implemented Sept. 2019

Covers most apparel Imports

Tariff increase cut to 7.5%

List 4b

\$160 billion

15 ppt tariff increase

Scheduled for Dec. 2019, but not implemented

Example of Tariff Increase

6204.62.80 W&G Cotton Bottoms

16.6% pre-increase tariff

+ 15 ppt increase

= 31.6% tariff on Chinese-made W&G Jeans


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
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




Change in Apparel Imports from China (year-over-year Sept.-Dec.)







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

Women's & Men's Jean Imports 2018





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





Summary & Implications

Shipments from China have gone down, but so have imports overall

Decrease in apparel demand has consequences upstream in supply chains

When extended across industries, macroeconomic effect is evident

Phase One helpful, but no clear path for a return back to pre-tariff world


